*We recognize many programs or projects expenses are beyond \$5,000 – we are looking to understand where you'd invest this mini-grant in your operations. **A program budget is not your organizational budget**, it is the budget that represents specific line items that correlate to activities with similar goals (a program). For example, an organization may have a food shelf program (addressing food security) and an after school tutoring program (addressing academic engagement). Their food shelf program budget would consist of all activities and costs related to addressing food security and would not include any costs related to increasing academic engagement such as school supplies, training for tutors, etc.
